1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, namely, Md. Azad @ Kallu who is in judicial custody since 11.05.2026 in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 317/2025 registered under Sections 305(b) of B.N.S. also heard learned P.P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case, in short, is that on 01.07.2025 motorcycle of the informant was stolen away by two unknown miscreants from Qabristan street of Qamruddinganj.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that earlier petitioner preferred an anticipatory bail petition bearing Cr. Misc. No. 12281/2026, which was rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide order dated 24.02.2026. Thereafter, the petitioner filed the present regular bail petition before this learned Court. Petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. rather his name transpired in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused person. The co-accused, Md. Guljar and Md. Faij have already been granted bail vide B.P. No.1048/2025 and B.P. No. 1310/2025 by this Court. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 3 of the bail petition and he is in custody since 11.05.2026. Petitioner is a substantial person and is ready to give sufficient sureties to the satisfaction of the Court. Based on above submissions, he has prayed that the petitioner be granted bail.

4. The Ld. P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

5. Perused the case record. The case was registered against unknown for committing theft of a motorcycle of the informant. During the course of investigation name of the petitioner has come in this case. The co-accused Md. Faij in his confessional statement has confessed his guilt and also stated name of co-accused Md. Guljar. The co-accused, namely,

P.T.O.

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Md. Guljar in his confessional statement has stated that he sold the stolen motorcycle to the petitioner for Rs. 5,000/- (vide para 41 of the case diary). From para 45 of the case diary it appears that the stolen motorcycle was recovered from shop of the petitioner, however the petitioner was not there. In this case investigation against the petitioner has been completed. Charge-sheet has been submitted under Sections 317(2), 305(b) of B.N.S. The petitioner has surrendered in the learned court concerned on 11.05.2026 and since then he is in custody. Statement has been made in para 3 of the bail petition that petitioner is not involved in any other case.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of this case and detention period of the petitioner in custody, the petitioner, Md. Azad @ Kallu is hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of **Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties** of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
