(1) This Anticipatory Bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, 1. Lokesh Kumar @ Laukesh Kumar, S/o.- Sunil Kumar, 2. Rubi Devi, W/o.- Sunil Kumar, Both resident of Village-Chorsua, P.S.- Giriyak, Distt.- Nalanda in connection with Giriyak P.S. Case No. 232/2026 registered U/S- 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2) 3(5) B.N.S. <u>PROSECUTION CASE</u> (2) The prosecution case, in brief, is that on 08.05.2026 at around 7:30 P.M., Sunil Kumar was erecting a pole near the vacant land near the house of the informant. When the informant's grandson Jaspal Kumar tried to stop him then Sunil Kumar started abusing and hitting the informant's grandson. Thereafter the informant's son Sunil Kumar went there, on which the accused Sunil Kumar, Lokesh Kumar, Karan Raj and Sunil Kumar's wife hit the informant's son with iron rods. The accused Sunil Kumar hit informant's son Sunil Kumar with iron rod, due to which the head of the informant's son was ruptured and his jaw was also broken. The injured Sunil Kumar was treated at Pawapuri Hospital from where he was referred to Patna AIIMS. <u>SUBMISSION OF THE COUNSEL OF THE PARTIES</u> (3) The petitioners have prayed for grant of anticipatory bail and have submitted as under: ● That the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence	

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		and falsely been implicated in this case due to village politics. ● That the petitioners have not filed any bail petition either anticipatory or regular earlier before this Court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. ● That the Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. ● That the allegations against the petitioners are baseless, false, concocted and due to land dispute the petitioners has been made an accused in the present case. ● That the alleged sections have got no application against the petitioners. (4) On the other hand learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the bail petition and has said that the offence is serious in nature and therefore petitioner does not deserve the benefit of the anticipatory bail. <u>MATERIAL ON RECORD AND OBSERVATIONS</u> (5) From the perusal of the record, it transpires that the informant and the witnesses have supported the prosecution case. The injury report shows that the injured Sunil Kumar had following injuries:- 1. Lacerated wound of size 2 cm x 1 cm x 0.5 cm over left parietal region of head 2. Abrasion of size 2 cm x 1 cm over left side of the neck 3. Swelling over left mandible & abrasion 1 x1 cm 4. Abrasion over medial side of right toe 2 cm x 1 cm. Radiological finding shows that there was deviated Nasal Septum (DNS) towards right with bilateral maxillan, ethmoid, frontal and sphenoid sinusitis. Fracture body of mandible in left side. NCCT head shows that there was comminuted fracture of the body of left hemimandible. The injuries are said to be grievous in nature. The nature of injury shows multiple fractures and multiple cracks in the jaw of the victim Sunil Kumar. The injuries are said to be so severe that he	
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	had to be referred to AIIMS Patna. (6) Considering the severity of the injuries caused, I am not inclined to grant the anticipatory bail to the Petitioner No. 1 Lokesh Kumar @ Laukesh Kumar. (7) As far as Petitioner No. 2 Rubi Devi is concerned, she is a female. Considering this, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner No. 2 Rubi Devi and the she is directed to be released on bail in the event of her arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of this order, on furnishing a bail bond of ₹10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of the learned lower court concerned.
