ORDER

The Present Regular bail petition filed on dated 29.05.26 on behalf of the petitioner accused namely **Manoj Kumar @ Ranjeet Kumar** who is in judicial custody since 15.02.2026 in connection with B.P. No.- 753/26 arising out of Nalanda Cyber P.S Case No.- 48/26 registered for the offence **U/s- 319(2), 318(4), 336(3), 340(2), 338 of BNS and Sec- 66(C), 66(D) of IT Act** is pressed today for hearing. Ld. Counsel for Petitioner accused and Ld. APP for State are present in the Court.

The case of the Prosecution as per FIR is that a police raiding party was constituted for verification of complaint no-33102260030100 received on cyber portal related to Mobile No-7398286614, Informant PSI namely Shailesh Kumar Jha left the police station with police party on 13.02.2026 at 18:30 and reached New Nalanda Colony and cordoned off the two storey building and apprehended two persons namely Manoj Kumar @ Ranjeet Kumar and Pankaj Kumar who was involved in the cyber crime and used to deceive people in the name of providing loan were apprehended by the police and on search three mobile phones were recovered from the physical possession of Manoj Kumar @ Ranjeet Kumar and two mobile phones were recovered from the physical possession of Pankaj Kumar and following articles were recovered from the room of the house

(I) four mobiles phones,

(ii) one Bajaj Pulsar Motorcycle bearing registration no-BR21AA7353 with logo of CRPF,

(iii) six Aadhar Card in the name of Ranjeet Kumar and Manoj Kumar and one PAN card in the name of Ranjeet Kumar,

(iv) five ATM cards of different banks and one Register with several mobile numbers

and thereafter, both the apprehended persons stated that one Akash Kumar provided them mobile phones, fake sim card and fake bank accounts and together they committed cyber fraud by sending APK files to people for loans and charging processing fees. By using the fake QR and UPI he used to withdraw money from fake mobile numbers. Inspection of seized mobiles revealed numerous E-mail IDs, transaction details and account details of various banks. Further, they stated that they used CRPF logo on his motorcycle to avoid police suspicion and thereafter seizure list was prepared and both persons were taken into custody and hence, the case.

Learned counsel for the Petitioner accused submitted that he has not committed any offence and has been falsely implicated in the present case and that Petitioner is under judicial custody since 15.02.2026. There is no any criminal antecedent against the petitioner accused as has been mentioned in para no-3 of bail petition and the allegations levelled against the petitioner accused is totally false and concocted. Earlier one bail petition vide BP No-427/26 was rejected by this court and after that no anticipatory or regular bail was filed before any superior court. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of petitioner and the house from where article has been recovered related to the case does not belongs to the petitioner even there is no connection of the petitioner with the alleged house. At last, it has been prayed to release the Petitioner accused on bail.

Learned APP for State opposed the prayer of bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Perusal of Case-Record shows that present case has been registered **U/s-319(2), 318(4), 336(3), 340(2), 338 of BNS and Sec- 66(C), 66(D) of IT Act** against petitioner accused along with other co-accused. This is the second bail petition of petitioner accused before this court. The earlier bail was rejected by this court when investigation was under progress. Now, Chargesheet has been submitted by the IO U/s- 318(4), 319(2), 336(3), 338, 340(2) of BNS and Sec- 66(C), 66(D) of IT Act. There is allegation against the petitioner accused that he used to deceive people on the name of providing loan by committing cyber fraud. Perusal of case-diary shows that no victims could be traced in this case. Perusal of para no-41 of case-diary shows that there is no any criminal antecedent against the present petitioner accused. Petitioner accused is under judicial custody since 15.02.2026.

*Therefore, considering the period of custody, Petitioner accused **Manoj Kumar @ Ranjeet Kumar** is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of like amount subject to the following conditions :-*

- (i) **Petitioner accused shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused and, that he shall co-operate in trial ;***
- (ii) **that he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Police/Court and Prosecution shall be at liberty to apply for cancellation of bail in case of non-compliance of aforesaid two conditions by accused;***

- (iii) **that One of the Bailor shall be either mother or father of the Petitioner accused.**
- (iv) **that he shall appear on each and every date till conclusion of trial and in case of default of appearance on two consecutive dates without any cogent reason, prosecution shall be at liberty to apply for cancellation of bail before the Ld. Trial Court.**
