<u>09.07.2026</u>	This anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely (1) Anuj Kumar S/o- Arjun Yadav, R/o Vill – Pachauri, P.S.- Deepnagar, Dist – Nalanda, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Biharsharif P.S. Case No. 283/2026, registered u/s- 69 of BNS. Shri Barun Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner, submitted that no bail application has previously been filed either before this Hon'ble Court or before the Hon'ble High Court. Learned counsel further submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and has not committed any offence whatsoever. It is submitted that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. The petitioner is a student, whereas the victim is a lady of questionable character who had attempted to negotiate a marriage with the petitioner. The petitioner had denied the said proposal as he was fully aware of the victim's character. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents, as stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition. Accordingly, learned counsel prayed for enlarging the petitioner on bail. Learned P.P. on the other hand has opposed the prayer for bail of petitioner. Having heard both sides and upon perusal of the case records, it appears that the present case was instituted on the basis of a written complaint lodged by the informant, Neha Kumari, wherein she has stated that while residing on rent at Patel Nagar, Patna, for her studies, she came in contact with the accused Anuj Kumar, son of Arjun Yadav, resident of	

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Contd... 09.07.2026	Village Pachauri, P.S. Deepnagar, District Nalanda, at Krishna Institute of Higher Education. It is alleged that the accused established physical relations with her for about two years on the false promise of marriage and also forcibly administered medicine when she became pregnant. On 14.05.2026, the accused was caught by her father at her rented room and was taken to Shastri Nagar Police Station, Patna, where she submitted an application against him. However, on the accused agreeing to marry her, a compromise was entered into and a marriage bond was prepared. Thereafter, on 16.05.2026, the accused called her to Bihar Sharif Civil Court for marriage. At the court premises, the accused, along with 8-10 associates, allegedly took away the documents prepared earlier and fled after the accused merely applied vermilion and exchanged garland with her. Upon perusal of the record, it transpires that the allegation against this petitioner is of sexually exploiting the informant for 2 years by deceiving her with false promise of marriage. The offence as alleged is very serious in nature and the Case Diary reveals that the investigation is still underway. Hence, this is not a fit case for grant of privilege of anticipatory bail.
