1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, namely, Suman Sharma, Satish Kumar and Sanjay Sharma who are in judicial custody since 22.05.2026 in connection with Asthawan P.S. Case No. 133/2026 registered under Sections 191(2), 115(2), 109(1), 329(3), 351(2) of B.N.S. Also heard learned P.P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case, in short, is that the informant was at his shop. On hearing hulla, he came to his house and saw the petitioners and two co-accused persons were abusing his wife. When he protested the accused persons assaulted him, his wife was also assaulted and misbehaved. It is further alleged that the petitioner no.1 assaulted him with lathi upon his head and also caused injury in his hand. The petitioner no.2 and co-accused Rajnish Kumar assaulted him with brick and stick.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that earlier no bail petition either regular or anticipatory on behalf of the petitioner has been filed either before the Court of Sessions or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. Petitioners are innocent, have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case due to village politics and enmity. Petitioners have no involvement in the alleged occurrence. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 3 of the bail petition and they are in custody since 22.05.2026. Petitioners are ready to furnish substantial sureties to the satisfaction of the Court and there is no chance of their absconding. Based on above submissions, he has prayed that the petitioners be granted bail.

4. The Ld. P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners.

5. Perused the case record and L.C.R. As per allegation the petitioners and co-accused persons assaulted the informant and his wife with intention to kill them. From para 45 and 54

of the case diary it appears that injury report of the informant was not prepared and doctor has stated to send the injury report to the Court. However, a medical prescription of the informant is available with case diary in which it is mentioned that lacerated wounds have been found on hand, temporal head and occipital head and dressing has been advised. Charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioners and one other under Section 115(2), 109(1), 3(5), 329(3), 351(2) of B.N.S. Petitioners are in custody since 22.05.2026. Statement has been made in para 3 of the bail petition that the petitioners are not involved in any other case.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of this case and detention period of the petitioners in custody, the petitioners, namely, Suman Sharma, Satish Kumar and Sanjay Sharma are hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of **Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties** of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
