1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Anurag Kumar @ Fantush, who is in judicial custody since 11.05.2026 in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 209/2026 registered u/s 305(a), 331(3), 62 of the B.N.S. 2023. Also heard learned P.P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case, in short, is that on 11.05.2026, one miscreant entered into locked house of the brother of the informant with intention to commit theft. One neighbour informed him, thereafter the miscreant was apprehended and he disclosed his name and address as of the petitioner. The petitioner was handed over to the Police.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that earlier, no bail petition either anticipatory or regular has been filed on behalf of petitioner either before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner has not committed any theft, nor any stolen property has been recovered from his possession. Only on the basis of suspicion, he was caught by the people and the informant and handed over to the Police. The petitioner doing the business of buying and selling scrap materials from a Thela in regarding with this trade, he was in the process of sorting through scrap near the informant's residence, where he was apprehended by the informant and made accused of theft. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 11.05.2026. Hence, the petitioner be granted bail.

4. On the other hand, Learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail.

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5. Perused the case record. As per allegation, the petitioner was apprehended, while he was trying to commit theft in locked house of the brother of the informant. From Para 20 of the case diary, it appears that investigation against the petitioner has been completed and charge-sheet has been submitted under Sections 305(a), 331(3), 62 of the B.N.S.. The petitioner is in custody since 11.05.2026. Submission has been made in Para 3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of this case, and detention period of the petitioner in custody, the petitioner Anurag Kumar @ Fantush is hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of **Rs. 10,000/-** with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
