1. Today a petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Dhananjay Kumar @ Abhishek Kumar stating therein that he has been arrested and he wants to withdraw his anticipatory bail application. Accordingly, prayer of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner Dhananjay Kumar @ Abhishek Kumar is hereby dismissed as withdrawn.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, 1. Abhijeet Kumar and 2. Ranjeet Kumar @ Ranjeet Ram @ Bhai, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Nalanda P.S. Case No. 115/2026 registered for the offences punishable u/s 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3) of the B.N.S. And also heard learned P.P. for the State.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that on 22.05.2026 at about 9:35 A.M., the petitioners and eight co-accused persons by creating a group assaulted the informant and his family members. The informant and his two brothers were assaulted brutally by Lathi, Bamboo and brick. The accused persons snatched gold chain from brother of the informant. Wife of the informant was also assaulted. The accused persons took away Rs. 50,000/- from cash box of the shop of informant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that earlier the petitioners have not filed any anticipatory or regular bail petition either before the court of sessions or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case due to village politics. The petitioners are labourers. The petitioners and informant are co-villager. The allegation against the petitioners are general and omnibus. Hence, the petitioners be granted anticipatory bail.

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5. On the other hand, Learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Perused the case record. As per allegation, the petitioners and other co-accused persons brutally assaulted the informant, his brothers and wife. They also committed theft of gold chain and Rs. 50,000/-. The witnesses in case diary, have supported the prosecution version. From injury report of the informant and other victims, it appears that the informant sustained two injuries on his scalp and forehead and his brother Sanjeev Kumar sustained grievous injury on his index finger. From para 34 of the case diary, it appears that the petitioners are not accused in any other case.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and nature of allegation, this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, 1. Abhijeet Kumar and 2. Ranjeet Kumar @ Ranjeet Ram @ Bhai, is hereby **rejected**.
