<u>16.06.2026</u>	This regular Bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely (1) Sujeet Kumar, S/o Dinesh Yadav, R/o Village/Moh– Gagan Diwan, P.S.- Laheri, Dist – Nalanda, who is in custody since 27.05.2026 in connection with Nalanda P.S. Case No. 89/2026, registered u/s 137(2), 140(3) of BNS. Learned counsel for the petitioner, Shri Rajesh Kumar Singh, submitted that no bail application has previously been filed on behalf of the petitioner either before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court. It was further submitted that the petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence, and has been falsely implicated in the present case. The petitioner is the husband of the victim's elder sister. Owing to certain family disputes and misunderstandings, the informant lodged the present case against him. Learned counsel further submitted that all disputes between the family members have now been amicably resolved and the parties are living peacefully. It was further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 27.05.2026 and has no criminal antecedent, as stated in paragraph 3 of the bail petition. Accordingly, learned counsel prayed that the petitioner be enlarged on bail. Learned P.P., on the other hand, opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner. The Ld. Lawyer on behalf of the informant is also present and submits that a compromise has been arrived at between the informant and the accused person. The compromise petition has also been annexed with the bail petition. Having heard both sides and upon perusal of the case records, it appears that the present case was instituted on the basis of a written complaint submitted by the informant, Shivam Kumar, wherein he has alleged that on 19.04.2026 at about 5:30 PM, his sister left their house and went missing. Despite extensive search and efforts made by the family, her whereabouts could	

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not be traced. The informant expressed suspicion against Sujit Kumar, son of Dinesh Yadav, resident of Gagan Diwan, District Nalanda, under Laheri Police Station, Bihar Sharif. It was further alleged that when attempts were made to contact the suspected person on mobile number 6200167395, the phone was found switched off.

Upon perusal of the case record, it appears that the victim girl has been recovered. No doubt she is minor, but in her statement recorded u/s 183 BNSS, she has not supported the allegation of kidnapping and has stated she had voluntarily gone away to her sister's house. The petitioner has claimed to have clean antecedent and is in custody since 27.05.2026.

Taking note of the aforesaid facts along with circumstances available on record, I find it judicious to enlarge the petitioner namely **(1) Sujeet Kumar** on bail. Accordingly, **he is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties** of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court.
