	29-06-2026	The anticipatory bail petition dated 08.06.2026 received to this Court on 10.06.2026 filed on behalf of the petitioner Kishori Chauhan @ Shiv Narayan Chauhan, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Deepnagar P.S. Case No. 150/2026 dated 23.03.2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 109, 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S., has been placed before me for order after hearing, a copy of it has already been supplied to the learned P.P. Heard the learned counsel Sri Navin Kumar for the petitioner as well as the learned P.P. Sri Anuj Kumar on behalf of the State. The prosecution story as per the written report of the informant Puja Kumari, in brief, is that on 22.03.2026 at about 7:00 PM, the informant was at her shop of General Merchant and her father-in-law and mother-in-law were at the house. At that time the accused Kishore Chauhan, Amrendra Kumar @ Feku, Bharat Kumar, Nagendra Kumar, Anil Chauhan, Deepak Kumar, Alpana Kumari, Kanti Devi, Nitu Devi, Anita Devi, Abhishek Kumar and Abhinandan Kumar armed with Lathi, Axe, cleaver and iron rod came there and they started making the customers flee away and also they started damaging the articles of the shop. When the informant's mother-in-law Sushma Devi and father-in-law Ramjanm Prasad protested to it, the accused Kishore Chauhan and Anil Chauhan assaulted Ram Chandra Prasad with cleaver and the accused Amrendra Kumar attacked on him with iron rod due to which his left arm got fractured and he sustained two cut injuries at his head. The accused Nagendra Kumar assaulted Sushma Devi with iron rod, Deepak Kumar assaulted her with iron axe, Kanti Devi and Anita Devi assaulted her with iron weighing unit due to which her head got swelled and she suffered with severe pain in the whole body. On hearing the alarm, the informant's husband Prem Kumar and brother-in-law Shashikant Sagar came to house and they saw that their mother and father are lying on the floor and smeared with blood. They also saw that the accused Kishore Chauhan, Bharat Kumar, Nagendra Kumar, are assaulting Puja Kumari and Shashikant's wife with iron rod and axe and the accused Abhishek Kumar, Abhinandan Kumar are misbehaving with them. When Shashikant Sagar Protested to it, the accused Anil Chauhan, Amrendra Kumar, Kishore Chauhan, Alpana Kumari started assaulting him with iron rod and axe due to which he sustained injury at his left palm. The accused Abhishek, Abhinandan, Anita and Anil assaulted the informant's husband with iron rod and axe due to which he sustained injury at his head. It has been further alleged that the accused Anita Kumar, Abhinandan and Amrendra took the informant's gold ring, mangalsutra and silver chain. The accused persons took away Rs. 20,000/- and the food items from the shop. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case by the informant on account of previous enmity and to save herself and her family members from the Deepnagar P.S. Case No. 151/2026 dated 23.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 109, 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S. There is no specific	

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	<u>Contd.</u> 29-06-2026	allegation against the petitioner as such the allegations are omnibus. Also, the petitioner is having one criminal antecedent and in this case the petitioner is on bail. On these facts, he prayed that the petitioner be granted anticipatory bail. The learned P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail. Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered U/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 109, 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S. and it appears that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. The injury reports as annexed with the case diary reflect that all the injuries are simple in nature except injury no. 2 of Ramjanam Prasad which is mentioned as pain and deformity left wrist. This injury does not appear to be on the vital part of the body. Further, there is case and counter case between the parties. Also, the other co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court. Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, petitioner Kishori Chauhan @ Shiv Narayan Chauhan is directed to be admitted on anticipatory bail on furnishing his bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court within one month from the communication of this order subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 B.N.S.S with further condition that the petitioner will remain physically present on each and every date till framing of charge.
