<u>17.06.2026</u>	This regular Bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely (1) Ravi, S/o Chandan Kumar, R/o Village/Moh-Nalanda Colony, Rehat par, Ramchandrapur, P.S.- Laheri, Dist – Nalanda, who is in custody since 29.03.2026 in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 517/2025, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 125, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS and 27 of Arms Act. Learned counsel for the petitioner, Shri Pramod Sharan Singh, submitted that the petitioner has not previously moved any bail application either before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court. It was contended that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case due to a prior altercation with the informant's son. Learned counsel further submitted that at the time of the alleged occurrence, the petitioner was residing at his maternal grandmother's house in Patna and came to know about his implication in the case only after returning to Bihar Sharif. It was further submitted that no specific allegation of assault or causing grievous injury has been attributed to the petitioner. Learned counsel also pointed out that co-accused Aman Kumar @ Rohit @ Mahakal and Raju Kumar have already been granted regular bail by this Court. It was lastly submitted that though the petitioner has two criminal antecedents, he is on bail in both the cases. Accordingly, prayer was made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner. Learned P.P., on the other hand, opposed the prayer for bail of

Having heard both sides and upon perusal of the case records, it appears that the present case was instituted on the basis of a written complaint submitted by the informant, Shyam Nandan Prasad, wherein he has alleged that on 15.11.2025 at about 8:00 P.M., when his son was returning home after closing his shop, six accused persons, arriving on two motorcycles, intercepted him near the informant's house. The accused persons allegedly started abusing and assaulting the informant's son with sticks and stones. When the informant and his wife intervened to save him, they were also assaulted. It is alleged that the informant sustained a fracture injury on his left hand and injuries on his head, while his son suffered multiple injuries on his body and forehead. The informant's wife also received injuries during the occurrence. The informant further alleged that the accused persons, namely Aman @ Mahakal, Ravi (both sons of Chandan Kumar), Raju Kumar, and three unknown associates, were involved in the assault. It was stated that the accused persons were known for creating nuisance and consuming intoxicants in a nearby vacant plot. The police were informed and the injured persons were taken to Sadar Hospital for treatment. The informant also alleged that during the course of treatment, he received information that the accused persons had pelted stones at his house, fired four to five rounds in the air, abused the family members, and threatened to kill the informant and his entire family before fleeing from the spot. Upon perusal of the record, it appears that the allegation levelled	
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
