1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, namely, Sunil Yadav who is in judicial custody since 31.05.2026 in connection with Harnaut P.S. Case No. 257/2026 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 74, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. Also heard learned P.P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case, in short, is that informant, Amrendra Kumar submitted his written report alleging therein that on 29.05.2026 at about 7:10 PM, the petitioner along with his mother, father and wife assaulted brutally the informant, his wife, brother and son. The petitioner assaulted with rod, brick and lathi to the informant and his family members. The petitioner used to abuse the informant and also used to quarrel for opening door in land of brother of the informant.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that earlier no bail petition either regular or anticipatory on behalf of the petitioner has been filed either before the Court of Sessions or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner and the informant are next door neighbors and there is dispute between them for opening door in way. There is case and counter case between the parties. There is no specific overt act against the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is ready to co-operate in the investigation and also ready to abide all the conditions imposed by the Court. Based on above submissions, he has prayed that the petitioner be granted bail.

4. The Ld. P.P. have vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

5. Perused the case record. As per allegation the petitioner and three co-accused persons assaulted the informant and his family members. The petitioner assaulted the informant and his family members brutally with rod, brick and lathi. Witnesses in the case diary have supported the prosecution version. From injury reports of the victims copied in para 48 of the case diary it appears that the brother of the informant, Bablu Kumar sustained injuries upon his occipital region and frontal region of scalp, grievous in nature. The other victims also sustained injuries on their person. The case is under investigation. Statement has been made in para 3 of the bail petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of this case and nature of allegation, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.
