(1) This regular Bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely 1. Ranjan Kumar, S/o- Sulendra Paswan, Village-Sarbahdi, P.S.- Manpur, Dist- Nalanda, who is in custody in connection with Sohsarai P.S. Case No. 178/2026 registered U/S- 305(b) of B.N.S. <u>PROSECUTION CASE</u> (2) The prosecution case in brief is that on 14.06.2026 at around 3:30 P.M., the informant was told by his neighbours that his bike has been stolen. Thereafter, he tried searching for his Hero Honda Splendor having Reg. No. BR21F-3916, but could not find it. <u>SUBMISSION OF THE COUNSEL OF THE PARTIES</u> (3) The learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed for grant of bail and has submitted as under: ● That the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the case. ● That the petitioner has not filed any anticipatory or regular bail petition earlier before this Court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. ● Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. ● The petitioner is in custody since 16.06.2026. ● That petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. ● The name of the petitioner was disclosed by co-accused Dharmveer Kumar. ● That the bike was sold to the petitioner by co-accused. (4) On the other hand, the learned APP has vehemently opposed the bail petition and has submitted that the offences are serious in nature and the petitioner does not deserve the benefit of bail. <u>MATERIAL ON RECORD AND FINDINGS</u> (5) From Para 27 of the case diary, it transpires that stolen motorcycle was recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The confessional	

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	statement of Dharmveer Kumar is attached with the case diary, in which Dharmveer Kumar has stated that he had sold the motorcycle to the petitioner for Rs. 7,000/-. Petitioner is in custody since 16.06.2026. He does not have any criminal antecedent. (6) Considering the period of custody and clean criminal antecedent of the petitioner, the bail petition is hereby allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each, with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
