<u>22.07.2026</u>	This regular Bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely (1) Siku Kumar @ Suku Kumar, S/o Sonam Ram, R/o Village/Moh– Pillichh, P.S.- Parwalpur, Dist – Nalanda, who is in custody since 09.07.2026 in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 141/2026, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. Sri Anandi Kumar Sinha, learned counsel for the petitioner, submitted that no bail application has previously been filed either before this Learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court. He further submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence whatsoever. It was contended that the petitioner and the informant are cousins by marriage (chachera saala) and brothers-in-law, and that owing to a dispute between them, the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case by being named in the FIR. It was further submitted that the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 09.07.2026 and has no criminal antecedent, as stated in paragraph no. 03 of the bail petition. Learned counsel further submitted that co-accused Rockey Kumar and Ravi Kumar @ Ravi Raj have already been granted regular bail vide order dated 02.06.2026 passed in B.P. No. 670 of 2026 and B.P. No. 680 of 2026, while co-accused Sampat Kumar has been granted the privilege of anticipatory bail vide order dated 19.06.2026 passed in A.B.P. No. 1182 of 2026. It was, therefore, prayed that the petitioner be enlarged on bail. Learned P.P. on the other hand has opposed the prayer for bail

Having heard both sides and upon perusal of the case records, it appears that the present case was instituted on the basis of a written complaint submitted by the informant, Suraj Kumar, wherein he has alleged that on 24.03.2026 at about 10:00 P.M., while he was selling momos from his roadside stall, a group of about 10–12 persons suddenly arrived and assaulted him. Among them, he identified Sampat Kumar, who was armed with an iron rod, and Bhola Prasad, Rockey Kumar, Ravi Kumar, and Suku Kumar, who were carrying sticks. The remaining assailants were unknown to him. It is alleged that all the accused persons jointly attacked the informant, causing a grievous injury to his head, for which he received 18 stitches. The informant further alleged that Sampat Kumar used to talk to his wife over the phone and had also provided her with a mobile phone. According to the informant, Sampat Kumar had earlier persuaded his wife to leave with him, but she subsequently returned. Thereafter, Sampat Kumar allegedly threatened the informant and, when his wife refused to accompany him, he along with his associates launched the present attack. The informant further stated that when a person came forward to rescue him, the accused persons also assaulted him with the iron rod, causing serious injuries to his head. Upon hearing the informant's cries for help, local residents gathered at the spot, whereupon all the accused persons fled away while threatening to kill the informant if he reported the matter to the police. It is apparent from the FIR that there is a general and omnibus allegation of assault against this petitioner. No specific overt act has been alleged and as per the injury reports annexed with Case Diary, both

<u>Contd.</u> <u>22.07.2026</u>	the injured are found to have sustained simple in nature, injury in form of laceration. He has claimed to have clean antecedent and the other co-accused namely Rockey Kumar and Ravi Kumar @ Ravi Raj have already been granted regular bail vide order dated 02.06.2026 passed in B.P. No. 670 of 2026 and B.P. No. 680 of 2026, respectively, while the co-accused Sampat Kumar has been granted the privilege of anticipatory bail vide order dated 19.06.2026 passed in A.B.P. No. 1182 of 2026. Taking note of the aforesaid facts along with circumstances available on record, I find it judicious to enlarge the petitioner namely Siku Kumar @ Suku Kumar on bail. Accordingly, he is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court.
