	30-07-2026	The regular bail petition dated 18-07-2026 received to this court on 10-07-2026 filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely, Rakesh Kumar@Majhala who is in Judicial custody since 24-05-2026 in connection with Sare P.S Case No. 96/2026 dated 23-05-2026 registered u/s 309(2) BNS has been placed before me for order after hearing, a copy of it has already been supplied to the learned Addl. P.P. Heard the Ld Counsel for the petitioner and the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State. The prosecution case as per fardbyan of the informant, namely, Sohan Paswan, in brief, is that on 23-05-2026 at about 5:00 P.M., the informant took iron pipe from Durga Steel shop and came to Nalanda and after handing over the pipe and taking payment of that(Rs.45,000/-) he was returning to Biharsharif. As soon he reached ahead Manpur Petrol Pump, four persons armed with Danda came there and started assaulting him. They took Rs. 45,000/- and mobile from him. It has been further mentioned in the fardbayan that he recognizes those persons and they are Uttam Kumar, Rakesh Kumar(Petitioner), Bhulla and Ravi Shankar Kumar. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is innocent and has not committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case. As a matter of fact the petitioner went to Manpur Petrol pump for taking petrol and he was arrested by the police and forwarded in the present case. The informant didn't identify the petitioner as both are of different village. He is in judicial custody since 24-05-2026. The co-accused Om Prakash @ Shivam has already been granted bail by the court of D.A.S.J-X, Nalanda. On the aforesaid grounds, the prayer for regular bail is made. The learned Addl.P.P. opposed the prayer for regular bail. Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered against the petitioner and others u/s 309(2) BNS. It further transpires that it is alleged that Rs.8,500/- were recovered from his possession. The injury report of the informant as annexed with the case diary shows that the informant sustained injury of swelling only at his back and the same has been assessed as simple in nature. Moreover, the petitioner is in judicial custody since 24-05-2026. Also, the other co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this court and the case of the petitioner stands on similar footing. Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of	

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	<u>Contd.</u> 30-07-2026	the case, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court with conditions that 1.
