	07-08-2026	The regular bail petition dated 18-07-2026 received to this court on 21-07-2026 filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, 1. Farhan and 2. Faizan who are in Judicial custody since 13-07-2026 in connection with Asthawan P.S Case No. 55/2026, has been placed before me for order after hearing, a copy of it has already been supplied to the learned Addl. P.P. Heard the Ld Counsel for the petitioners and the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State. The prosecution story as per written report of the informant Md. Jamaluddin, in brief, is that on 13-02-2026 at about 01:10 P.M the accused Farhan, Faizan, Bobby, Akbar Raja and Md. Irfhan went to pray at the mosque and they started assaulting the informant by surrounding him. Meanwhile, the accused Md. Irfhan and Farhan attacked at his private part with knife by which he sustained cut injury at his private part and stitches were made at Referral Hospital Asthawan. The accused persons also pelted stone at his house and they abused and used indecent word with his wife and daughter. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. It has been further submitted that no specific overt act regarding causing injury has been assigned to the petitioners. The allegations are general and omnibus and the custodian interrogation is not required in this case. On the aforesaid grounds, the prayer for regular bail is made. The learned Addl.P.P. opposed the prayer for regular bail. Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered against the petitioners and others u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 118(1), 74, 352 and 3(5) BNS. It further transpires that the allegation against the petitioners is that they along with other co-accused assaulted the informant and they got the private part of the informant injured by attacking with knife. The injury report as annexed with the case diary shows that the injury sustained by the informant has been assessed as simple in nature. The record also shows that

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	<u>Contd.</u> 07-08-2026	in this case the chargesheet has already been submitted and nothing came in the case diary which could show that the petitioners ever tried to tamper with the evidence. Moreover, the petitioners are in judicial custody since 13-07-2026. Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court.
