1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, Chandan Kumar @ Kaliya, who is in custody since 27.05.2026 in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 234/2026 registered for the offences punishable u/s 305(a), 118(1) of the B.N.S. Also heard learned P.P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case, in short, on 26.05.2026 at about 1.00 'O' Clock, the informant found that 60 meters wire of Meter had been cut away. Thereafter, he went to his another house from where he saw one person entering his house. Thereafter, he came towards his house and saw that a person was fleeing with starter of motor. He was chased and apprehended. During course of apprehending him, the miscreant inflicted blade blow causing injury in his hand. Thereafter, the police was informed and the miscreant was handed over to the police. He disclosed his name and address as of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner has not filed any anticipatory or regular bail petition either before the court of sessions or before the Hon'ble Court. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case due to enmity. There is no iota of truth in the alleged prosecution story rather this accused petitioner and informant reside in same Mohalla and due to enmity, the petitioner has been indulged in this case by the informant. The petitioner denied entire allegation, which is levelled against him. The inserted sections are not applicable in this case.

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Hence, the petitioner be granted bail.

4. On the other hand, Learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

5. Perused the case record. As per allegation, the petitioner was caught by the informant while he entered the house of the informant for committing theft. From para 26 of the case diary, it appears that the petitioner is also accused in one case of Excise Act. In this case, investigation has been completed and charge sheet has been submitted against the petitioner and accordingly, cognizance has been taken u/s 305(a), 62 of the B.N.S. The petitioner is in custody since 27.05.2026.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, nature of allegation and detention period of the petitioner in custody, the petitioner, Chandan Kumar @ Kaliya, is hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of **Rs. 10,000/-** with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
