Criminal Miscellaneous Case No. 19 / 2019

Lilam Devin @ Gavo Vs. The State of Bihar

18.07.2019

The present Miscellaneous petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner Lilam Devin @ Gavo, stating therein that petitioner was granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 11.07.2017 passed in A.B.P. No. 1633/2017 by the then Sessions Judge, Nalanda, in which the petitioner was directed to surrender before the learned court below within a month from the date of passing of the order. But she could not surrender in time before the learned court below due to misunderstanding of fact. Lastly it has been prayed to extend time for her surrender.

Heard.

From perusal of the order dated 11.07.2017 passed in A.B.P. No. 1633/2017 in connection with Mahila P.S. case No. 52/2014, it transpires that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail with direction to surrender before the learned court below within a month from the date of the order. But, despite the direction of the court, the petitioner did not surrender before the learned Court below and after passing of more than 2 years, the present Misc. case has been filed for extension of period of surrender on behalf of the petitioner. The petitioner deliberately and knowingly avoided the order of the court and she did not get benefit of the anticipatory bail as granted by the then Sessions Judge, Nalanda.

After considering the entire facts and materials, the court do not find any merit in this Miscellaneous petition of the petitioner. Accordingly, the miscellaneous petition is hereby **dismissed**.
