The State of Bihar Vs. Shankar Sao

Bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner Shankar Sao, S/o Sitaram Sao, who is in judicial custody since 24.10.2021 in a case registered u/s. 20(b) of the N.D.P.S. Act bearing Case No. 249C3Ex/2021.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he had possessed 13 Puriya in a box of Margo soap and during course of search, it was found that was Ganja, total weight of the said Puriya was 0.031 gm. The report was called for from excise department but till today, no latest report has been submitted.

Heard the Ld counsel Sri Deepak Kumar Rastogi for the petitioner as well as the Ld Spl. P.P. Sri Lalit Kumar Mourya on behalf of the State.

Learned Lawyer of the petitioner has submitted that only 0.031 gm Ganja was recovered that was in small quantity. Accused is in judicial custody since 24.10.2021. On these facts, he has prayed that the accused be granted bail.

Learned Spl. Public Prosecutor has also admitted the fact that the alleged recovery in small quantity.

Heard and perused the case record. From perusal of case record, it transpires that 0.031 gm Ganja was recovered from the possession and Excise Department has not submitted final report up till now. No further investigation has been co-related the involvement of petitioner.

Considering all these facts, I am of opinion, the accused may be granted bail. Accordingly, he is granted bail of **Rs.10,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of this Court.
