| | 30-03-2026 | <p>The anticipatory bail petition dated 06.12.2025 received to this Court on 09.12.2025 filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, (1)Nisha Ravidas, (2) Savita Devi, (3) Dhanbanti Devi, (4) Pushan Ravidas and (5) Arvind Ravidas, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Ben P.S. Case No. 247/2025 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 303(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S., has been placed before me for order after hearing, a copy of it has already been supplied to the learned Addl.P.P.</p> <p>Heard the learned counsel Sri Ravi Raman for petitioners as well as the learned A.P.P. Sri Sunil Kumar Sinha on behalf of the State.</p> <p>The prosecution story as per the written report of the informant Babita Kumari, in brief, is that on 19.11.2025 at about 03:00 PM , her son Brajesh Kumar was coming in a tempo carrying paddy. On the way to Ravidas Tola, the accused (i) Tushan Ravidas, (ii) Pushan Ravidas, (iii) Nisha Ravidas, (iv) Arvind Ravidas, (v) wife of Arvind Ravidas and (vi) wife of Sagar Ravidas, all were sitting on the road. The informant's son said to leave the way, then all the accused persons started abusing. When her son protested to it, the accused persons started assaulting him with fist and slaps. Then, the informant's son phoned her elder son Chandan Kumar and called him. The informant and Chandan Kumar went to save Brajesh Kumar, the accused persons started assaulting Chandan Kumar also. The accused Tushan Ravidas assaulted Chandan Kumar with Khanti due to which his head was broken and blood started oozing out. The accused Nisha Ravidas and wife of Arvind Kumar assaulted Brajesh Kumar with lathi-danda by which he sustained injuries. The accused Nisha Ravidas took out gold chain and locket of Bajrangbali. On hearing the alarm, the friends of informant's son namely Shubham Kumar and Rudal Kumar, came to save them, then, the accused Arvind Ravidas assaulted them with Khanti by which both of them sustained severe injuries in their heads and fell down.</p> <p>The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner are innocent and have committed no offence rather they have falsely been dragged and implicated in the present case only to save the skin from counter case as Ben P.S. Case No. 246/2025 lodged by Tushan Ravidas against the atrocity of Scheduled case. The allegation of snatching of chain and locket. Moreover, the injury report did not corroborate the allegation. The petitioner nos. 1 to 4 are ladies. The petitioners have got no any criminal antecedent. Moreover, both the parties have entered into compromise. On these facts, he prayed that the petitioners be granted anticipatory bail.</p> <p>The learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail</p> | |

| | <p><u>Contd.</u> 30-03-2026</p> | <p>but conceded on the point of compromise.</p> <p>Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered U/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 303(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S. on 19.11.2025 and for the occurrence of same date the petitioners side have also earlier filed a case under SC/ST Act. Further, the petitioners have mentioned in the bail petition that they are not having any criminal antecedent and nothing contrary to it has come in the case diary received for hearing of this bail petition. Also, both the parties have entered into compromise and for that they have filed a joint compromise petition before the Court.</p> <p>Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, petitioners, namely, (1)Nisha Ravidas, (2) Savita Devi, (3) Dhanbanti Devi, (4) Pushan Ravidas and (5) Arvind Ravidas are directed to be admitted on anticipatory bail on furnishing their bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court within four weeks of this order subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 B.N.S.S..</p> <p align="right">Dictated & corrected Sd/- (Khyati Singh) Addl.
