The record was presented for passing the order. The anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the applicants 1. Indal Paswan 2. Sumit Paswan 3. Ashok Paswan 4. Vijay Paswan 5. Raushan Paswan were conducted by his Ld. Counsel, Sarvjeet Kumar. The applicant is involved in Parwalpur P.S. Case No.- 244/2025, dated 03.02.2026, U/s- 126(2), 324(2), 351, 303(2), 308(2), 3(5) B.N.S.

Prosecution story in brief is that on 08.11.2025 at 4 P.M. looted his paddy crops with cutting harvester machine by Rangdar peoples which paddy crops price 30,000 Rs. Who named accused persons when the informant opposed his cutting paddy crops the all accused and accused Indal Paswan held again to informant head and Ashok Paswan catch his hand and demand rangdari five lacks Rs. And threatening all family killed and accused Vijay Paswan snatched gold chain.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that Earlier no anticipatory or regular bail petition has been filed by the petitioners either before your honour or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. There is no criminal history against the petitioners. All sections except 303(2), 308(2) B.N.S. are bailable and sections 303(2), 308(2) B.N.S. are super addition. Due to land dispute the petitioner and informant and the petitioner Vijay Paswan has been filed title suit Np. 183/2025 against the informant save their skin filed false case and false allegation against the petitioners. The petitioners is simple poor farmers and he is belongs to respectable family. Conditions of Section 482(2) B.N.S. at all times and there is no possibility of absconding.

The anticipatory bail was opposed by the Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor.

Perused the case record it transpires that there is no criminal antecedent in given C.D. As per para 3 of this petition there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner. As per supplementary petition there is one other case against the petitioner. In another case case filed by prosecution petitioners have not been charge-sheeted. There is allegation of theft of paddy against the petitioner. There is pending title suit between the parties.

In such a situation, keeping the above facts in mind, the facility of anticipatory applicant accused 1. Indal Paswan 2. Sumit Paswan 3. Ashok Paswan 4. Vijay Paswan 5. Raushan Paswan within one month from the date of this court's order on submitting a bond of Rs. 10,000/- and two sureties of the same amount till he surrenders the anticipatory bail filed by him in the trial court or on a bail bond at the time of arrest. On the basis of the satisfaction of the trial court, an order is given to release him on anticipatory bail under the conditions of section 482(2) B.N.S.
