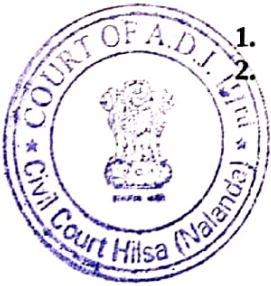

ORDER
DATED-03-07-2026



1. The Petitioners / Revisionist herein above has preferred this criminal revision against the order dated 05/02/25 passed by Ld. S.D.M. Hilsa, in Case No. 93(M)/25 initiated by the Ld. S.D.M. under section 126 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, (Section 107 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973) whereby both parties were directed to appear before the court of Ld. S.D.M on date fixed (i.e. 11/02/25) and to file their respective show-cause. Apart from that the notice issued to both parties, the Ld. S.D.M. also directs them for execution of a bond for Rs. 2,00,000/- alongwith two surety of the like amount till 11/02/25.

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2. The revisionists herein were the 2nd party while the respondent no. 2 herein was the 1st party in Case no. 93(M)/25. It appears that the impugned order dated 05/02/25 has now lost its force in view of the provision laid down under section 126 (1) and 136 (a) of B.N.S.S., 2023, the operative portion of which runs as follows:- Section 126(1) B.N.S.S. "When an Executive Magistrate xxxxxxxxxxxxxx for keeping the peace for such period not exceeding one year, as the Magistrate thinks fit." Further section 136 (a) B.N.S.S. states that no person shall be ordered to give security of a nature different from, or of an amount larger than, or for a period longer than, that specified in the order made under section 130 (the show-cause notice).
3. In view of the facts and the express provisions of law aforementioned, this Revision petition has now become infructuous and as such the same stands dismissed. Office clerk is directed to sent the Copy of the order along with the Trial Court Record to the Court of S.D.M, Hilsa for information and compliance. The Criminal Revision file be consigned to record room after compliance of other necessary legal formalities.
