The record was presented for passing the order. The anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the applicants 1. Kishore Paswan 2. Subhash Paswan 3. Anil Paswan 4. Rahul Paswan Paswan were conducted by his Ld. Counsel, Arvind Kumar. The applicant is involved in Karaiparsurai P.S. Case No.- 65/2024, dated 19.02.2026, U/s- 341, 323, 448, 147, 149, 504, 506, 354(B) I.P.C.

Prosecution story in brief is that on 05.05.2024 at about 12 O'clock the informant of this case Sima Kumari was present in her house then at this time all the petitioners along with eight persons namely in the F.I.R. and three unknown persons came to the house of the informant and started abusing and when the informant protest theirs such act then all the petitioners along with others pulled down the informant with bad intention by which is is alleged by the informant became partly naked after this all the petitioners assaulted him with fits and when his husband and son came for rescue the informant then all of them assaulted his son and husband which sustained injured. Accused person Bicky Kumar snatched her golden ear ring, Rahul Kumar and Subhash also snatched mobile phone of Samsung and Oppo company.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that Earlier no bail petition either for anticipatory bail or for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner before any court. There are no any criminal antecedent against the petitioners which is mentioned in the para 46 of the case diary. Now charge-sheet has been submitted in this case only against petitioners and others F.I.R. named 8 persons not sent up for trial. On such submission of charge sheet the Ld. Court of Sri Anurag taken cognizance on dated 27.01.2025 against the petitioners as per C.S. and ordered to issue summon against the petitioners for appearance. Petitioners was on the benefit of 41(A)

Cr.p.c. given by the police and obey the conditions their P.R. Bond. Except sec. 354(B) other sections areailable. Allegation is general and omnibus. The applicant is ready to abide by all the terms and conditions of Section 482(2) B.N.S. at all times and there is no possibility of absconding.

The anticipatory bail was opposed by the Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor.

Perused the case record it transpires that there is no criminal antecedent in para no. 3 of this petition. Petitioners were given benefit of sec. 41(A) Cr.p.c. during investigation. After cognizance summons have been issued.

In such a situation, keeping the above facts in mind, the facility of anticipatory applicants accused 1. Kishore Paswan 2. Subhash Paswan 3. Anil Paswan 4. Rahul Paswan Paswan within one month from the date of this court's order on submitting a bond of Rs. 10,000/- and two sureties of the same amount till he surrenders the anticipatory bail filed by him in the trial court or on a bail bond at the time of arrest. On the basis of the satisfaction of the trial court, an order is given to release him on anticipatory bail under the conditions of section 482(2) B.N.S.
