The record was presented for passing the order. The bail application filed on behalf of the applicant Rajesh Yadav @ Rajesh Kumar @ Gorelal Yadav was conducted by his Ld. Counsel, Mahesh Prasad. The applicant is involved in Tharthari P.S. Case No.- 165/2025, dated 25.02.2026, U/s- 303(2), 334(2), 134, 126(2), 351(2) B.N.S.

Prosecution story in brief is that on 17.12.2025 at 11.00 p.m. unknown persons entered into the house of the informant Upendra Paswan and took away the buffalo and they were searching gold in nose, ear and neck.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that the petitioner is innocent. Petitioners have two cases Tharthari P.S. 135/25 & Tharthari P.S. 133/25. petitioner arrested in this case on 28.01.2026 and his confessional statement was police record and petitioner except the thief articles. Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. F.I.R. has been lodged after great delay. Petitioner is in custody since 28.01.2026. The petitioner is ready to furnish the substantial surety to the satisfaction of the court.

The anticipatory bail was opposed by the Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor.

Perused the case record it transpires that criminal antecedent not given in C.D. As per para 3 of this petition there are two other cases against him. F.I.R. lodged against unknown persons. Petitioners name cropped up as stated by sources and his confessional statement.

Therefore, keeping in view all the above facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of the charge, the applicant
