Both parties have filed attendance. On call learned counsel for the applicant appeared. No one appeared on behalf of the opposite parties on repeated call. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and perused the record.

This miscellaneous case has been filed on behalf of the applicant under section 24 of the code of civil procedure praying therein to transfer either T.S. No.-900/22 pending in the court Ld. Sub Judge II, Nawada to the court of Ld. Sub Judge VII, Nawada or T.S. No.-95/23 pending in the court of Ld. Sub Judge VII, Nawada to the court of Ld. Sub Judge-II Nawada on this ground that plaintiffs and defendants of both suits are descendants of one Babu Yamuna Singh, legal issues involved in both the suits are one and same and the lands involved in Title Suit 95/23 stands included in Title Suit no.-900/22. The applicant is plaintiffs in Title Suit no.- 95/23 and sole defendant in title suit no. 900/22.

On the other hand, the opposite parties by way of rejoinder opposed transfer of any of the aforesaid suits to another court but they admit that parties of both suits are descendants of same person and suit land of T.S. No.-95/2023 stands included in that of T.S. No.-95/2023.

Considering the facts and circumstances, the prayer made is hereby allowed with order to transfer T.S. No.-95/2023 pending in the court of Ld. Sub Judge VII, Nawada to the court of Ld. Sub Judge-II, Nawada for hearing and disposal. Accordingly, the instant Miscellaneous case stands disposed of. Office is directed to send order of this court to both concerned court and consign the case record in Record Room, Nawada as per rule.
