This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **Vijay Kumar** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Nardiganj P.S Case No.- 303/2024** registered U/Ss. 331(4)/305 B.N.S. Copy of this A.B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Prosecution story in short is that on 03.09.2024 at about 06:00 A.M. the room of her elder son was found locked from outside. Then, her elder daughter-in-law opened the door of the room and it was seen that theft was committed from the room situated beside stair. Godrej-almirah was found opened and all ornaments and rupees five thousand was stolen from it. She has suspected that accused petitioner had committed the offence.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged. He has been falsely implicated in the case. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Witnesses have supported the case of prosecution in para no.- 8,9,10 of case diary. Allegation is of committing theft in the dwelling house of informant in night. Investigation is still going on. Offence is serious in nature.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail, as such his prayer for anticipatory bail stands **rejected**.
