J U D G E M E N T

1. Above named accused stand charge for the offence punishable u/s 307/149, 341, 323, 504, 147 I.P.C. and u/s 27 Arms Act as a member of unlawful assembly in prosecution of common object and committed offence of assaulting Sanjay Kumar, Laxmikant Sharma and Manoj Kumar by means of fire arms and iron rod with intention to kill them by restraining them and abusing them also.
2. Case of prosecution in short is that on 12.09.2007 at about 12:30 P.M. informant and other persons assembled at the girls primary school for participating in election of Siksha Samiti. In the mean time accused persons came there and starting abusing him and also threatened him. Accused Manoj Singh and Subodh Singh assaulted him by iron rod causing injuries near his eyes accused Munna Singh fired from rifle. When Sanjay Kumar and Manoj Kumar came for his rescue, both have also been assaulted by accused persons causing bleeding injury from their head.
3. The instant case instituted on the basis of written application filed by the informant with Nardiganj P.S. case no.- 65/2007 on 12.09.2007. Police investigated into the matter and filed charge sheet and accordingly cognizance u/s 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 504 of I.P.C. and 27 Arms Act was taken against them vide order dated 16.10.2009 and case record was committed to the court of Sessions on 27.10.2010. Charges against accused persons were framed on 28.12.2010 and trial proceeded. After travelling from different court, the case record received to this court on 18.12.2021 in favour of trial and disposal.
4. The accused denied the charges leveled against him during examination u/s 313 Cr.P.C.

5. The point for determination is: Whether the prosecution has been able to prove the charges leveled against the accused beyond all reasonable doubt?

FINDINGS

6. Altogether two witnesses have been examined by the prosecution. They are P.W. 1 Tiro Singh @ Triveni Singh and P.W. 2 Rajendra Ram @ Rajendra Kahar. Both these witnesses have turned hostile and stated in their respective evidences that they did not know about the occurrence and also not stated anything to the police.
7. After going through the evidence on record I find that the two witnesses examined by the prosecution have turned hostile during there evidence and stated that they did not know anything about the occurrence. Thus, there is nothing on the record in support of allegation levelled against accused persons and they are accordingly acquitted of the charges levelled against them. They have also discharged liabilities from the bail bond.
