This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner 1. **Dharmendra Kumar** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Akbarpur P.S Case No. 368/2025** registered U/Ss. 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118, 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) B.N.S. Copy of this A.B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Prosecution story, in short, is that informant got an information on 31.07.2025 at about 02:30 P.M. that accused Kundan Singh and his mother Saro Devi were ploughing his purchased land. On information, he reached there and objected them upon which accused Kundan Singh called other accused persons by mobile phone. Further, it has been alleged that accused Pramanand Singh along with other 10 persons came there and handed over Katta to accused Kundan Singh who fired upon the informant but fortunately he saved himself. Then accused Pramanand Singh assaulted by spade to injured Randhir Kumar on his head causing bleeding injury and accused Sanni Kumar assaulted Jitendra Kumar by Khanti. Accused Dharmendra Kumar and accused Tullu Kumar have also assaulted injured Sailendra Kumar. Accused Bullu Kumar assaulted Jitendra Kumar. Lastly, it has been alleged that accused Surendra Singh snatched golden chain of informant and Saro Devi snatched locket of both of informant.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged. He has been falsely implicated in the case. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Case diary is available

on the record. Witnesses have supported in para 2,6,7 of case diary. There is allegation against the petitioner that he has assaulted injured Sailendra Kumar. Para 16 shows that petitioner has one criminal antecedent also. Investigation is still going on.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail, as such his prayer for anticipatory bail stands **rejected**.
