This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners **1. Dilip Kumar @ Dilip Yadav 2. Vimlesh Kumar @ Vimal Kumar** and **3. Satendra Yadav** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with **Govindpur P.S Case No. 261/2025** registered U/Ss. 126(2), 115(2), 329(4), 76, 117(2), 303(2), 324(4), 352, 351(2), 3(5) B.N.S. Copy of this A.B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Prosecution story, in short, is that on 21.08.2025 at about 09:00 A.M. accused petitioner along with their other family members went to the house of informant and started abusing her due to fall of rain water. It has further been alleged that petitioner Dilip Yadav took off her Saree, and assaulted on her right hand by lathi. When her daughter Punak Kumari came for rescue, she was assaulted by accused Vimlesh Kumar with fist and slap. Lastly, it has been alleged that accused Manju Devi snatched her golden Jitia Mangalsutra and accused Satyendra Yadav damaged articles of her house.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged. They have been falsely implicated in the case. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer of the petitioners for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Witnesses have supported the occurrence in para no.- 6, 7 of case diary. Injury report of injured Dulari Devi shows nature of injury is simple. Petitioners are Gotia.

In the light of discussion made above, the court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, anticipatory bail petition of

petitioners is **allowed** and it is ordered that in the event of arrest/surrender, they will be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court within four weeks of this order subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) BNSS. Further condition is that one bailor must be family member of the petitioners and they will not commit such offence in future.
