This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner 1. **Raju Kumar Verma** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Govindpur P.S Case No. 303/2025 registered U/Ss. 318(4) B.N.S & 23 PC & PNDT Act 1994. Copy of this A.B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

As per prosecution case on dated 09.10.2025 at about 03:00 P.M., a team of doctor comprising Civil Surgeon, Nawada and other doctors including the informant, who is incharge Medical Officer, P.H.C., Govindpur, an inspection was made at the M/s. Ashirbad ultrasound center, Thana Road, Govindpur and it was found that the center was neither registered nor it has Pollution Certificate, Fire Extinguisher Certificate and Bio Medical Waste Certificate. It was found that petitioner was conducting ultrasound but he managed to escape from there. It was informed by Rubi Kumari and Tulsi Kumari that petitioner used to conduct ultrasound at the center. During inspection, it has also came to light that the ultrasound center is not registered and it used to conduct secretly sex determination test of fetus.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged. He has been falsely implicated in the case. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. In para no.- 4 and 5 witnesses have supported the prosecution case. Petitioner runs ultrasound center having no registration number and conduct sex determination test of foetus which is against the law causing imbalance of male-female ratio in society.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail, as such his prayer for anticipatory bail stands **rejected**.
