This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners **1. Suman Kumari 2. Punam Kumari 3. Manju Devi 4. Ravi Raushan @ Raushan Kumar and 5. Musafir Chaudhary** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with **Rajauli P.S Case No.- 357/2025** registered U/Ss. U/Ss. 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 127(2), 308(3), 118(1), 117(2), 109, 324(4) (5), 352, 351(1) B.N.S. Copy of this A.B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Prosecution story, in short, is that on 04.07.2025 at about 09:00 A.M., Virendra Chaudhary called the informant at his house and held him as hostage and abused, assaulted with lathi danda, threatened and also demanded Rs. 50,000/- as extortion. When informant refused to give money, they locked him in the house but somehow he managed to escape and informed his relatives about the occurrence. It has further been alleged that nephew of informant came to save him, then accused Virendra assaulted him with bricks on his head and he got injured and when informant tried to save him, then accused Vinod Chaudhary assaulted on informant's leg with lathi and accused Mosafir assaulted on his hand with Pasuli. It is again alleged that all other the accused persons surrounded the informant and his family and started abusing and throwing bricks, stones due to which his family members were also injured.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged. They have been falsely implicated in the case. Petitioner no.-5 has three criminal antecedents.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer of the petitioners for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Allegation against petitioner Musafir Chaudhary is of assaulting informant by Fasuli on hand causing cut injury. Witnesses have supported in para 04, 05, 11, 12 of case diary. Para 29, 30 of case diary mentioned injury report of Rintu Kumar and Prince Kumar and nature of injury of both injured found as simple is nature. There is general and omnibus allegation against other petitioners of pelting stone on the vehicle of informant.

In the light of discussion made above, the court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, anticipatory bail petition of petitioners **is allowed** and it is ordered that in the event of arrest/surrender, they will be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court within four weeks of this order subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) BNSS.
