This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **Ramfal Yadav @ Gore** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Nemdarganj P.S. case no.- 419/2025** registered U/Ss. 103(1)/3(5) B.N.S. Copy of this A.B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Prosecution story, in short, is that on 26.11.2025 at about 08:00 P.M. accused petitioners along with accused Suraj Kumar and Ramphal Yadav tried to take away the husband of informant from his house which was objected by her but accused-persons succeeded in taking her husband away. By 10:00 P.M. her husband did not return back to his home, On the next morning, it was informed by people of village Derma that dead body of a person was found lying near Derma Tola, Neemtala village. Informant along with her family members and villagers went there and identified the dead body of her husband namely Ravindra Yadav @ Kailu. He was killed by hitting of his head with brick and stones.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged. He has been falsely implicated in the case. Petitioner has two criminal antecedents.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Witnesses have supported the occurrence in para 6,7,10,119,120,121 and 122 of case diary. Postmortem report shows, the cause of death is head injury due to heavy, hard and blunt object. Petitioner is named accused person and there is allegation of committing murder of husband of informant.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail, as such his prayer for anticipatory bail stands **rejected**.
