This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **Rambalak Chaudhary** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Sirdalla P.S Case No. 254/2025** registered U/Ss. 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 303(2) B.N.S. Copy of this A.B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Prosecution story, in short, is that on 01.07.2025 at about 08:30 A.M accused Santosh Chaudhary, Sanjay Chaudhary and Shambhu Chaudhary along with twenty unknown persons weilded with iron rod, Khanti, Chapad, came on the purchased Parti land of the informant and started construction thereon. It has also been alleged that there is a Title Suit no.- 03/22 is pending with respect to this land. Further allegation is that when husband and son of informant objected, accused persons, accused Santosh Chaudhary assaulted on the head of her husband by Chapad, accused Anil Chaudhary assaulted the informant by iron rod on her neck and waist. Accused Sahmbhu Chaudhary has also assaulted her. Again it has been alleged that accused Ajay Chaudhary and Sanjay Chaudhary assaulted daughter of informant by iron rod on her head, it has again be alleged that accused Durga Chaudhary assaulted daughter-in-law of informant namely Rinku Devi and accused Lalita Devi assaulted to Anita Kumari. Other accused persons pelted stones upon them causing injuries. Allegation of taking away of ornaments has also been made.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged. He has been falsely implicated in

the case. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. There is land dispute between the parties. Injury report of injured mentioned in para 14, 22 and 23 of case diary shows following injuries: (i) Renu Kumari has abrasion on forehead (ii) Ramswaroop Chaudhary has abrasion on nose (iii) Rinku Devi has pain and swelling on the left shoulder joint (iv) Kunti Devi has back pain (v) Dilip Chaudhary has abrasion on the left middle finger and (vi) Anita Kumari has abrasion on the forehead. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner of peltings stones.

In the light of discussion made above, the court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, anticipatory bail petition of petitioners **is allowed** and it is ordered that in the event of arrest/surrender, they will be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court within four weeks of this order subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) BNSS. Further condition is that one bailor must be family member of the petitioner.
