This Bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **Shashikant Kumar** who is in custody since 23.02.2026 in connection with **Hisua P.S Case No.- 237/2025** registered U/Ss. 64(1)/64(2)(m)/351(2)(3)/303(2) B.N.S. Copy of this B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged and he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent.

Learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. The prosecution story in short is that informant went to appear in B.A. part-1 examination with accused-petitioner Shashikant Kumar and after the exam informant had to appear in practical exam and then accused petitioner Shashikant Kumar took the informant to his rented house at Rajendra Nagar and said that informant should meet her sister-in-law. Informant further alleged that after going there, accused petitioner Shashikant Kumar took her in a room and switched off her mobile and forcibly made physical relation with her. Informant further alleged that after that, she got scared and went to her parental house. Informant further alleged that after the incident, accused-petitioner Shashikant Kumar kept calling her repeatedly and said that if she doesn't come, he will viral informant's photo and video on social media and kill informant's husband and also threatened to rape her daughter. Informant further alleged that in this manner accused-petitioner Shashikant Kumar made physical relation regularly from 08.04.2025 to 26.01.2025 by threatening her. It is further alleged that when informant went to her in-

law's house, then the petitioner started putting photos on whats App on 14.04.2025 and from 18.04.2025 accused-petitioner started making informant's obscene photos and videos viral by creating a fake-ID in informant's name on Instagram and Facebook. Informant further alleged that the petitioner also took her mobile phone and ATM cards. Witnesses in para 2,3 and 4 of case diary support the story of prosecution. Informant has also supported her case during statement recorded u/s 183 B.N.S.S. Allegation against petitioner is of committing rape with informant. Investigation is still going on.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation, the petitioner is not entitled to be enlarged on bail, as such his prayer for granting regular bail is hereby **rejected**.
