09.04.2026	<p>This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Raja Kumar, who is in custody since 21.02.206 in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No.66 of 2026 under Sections 303(2), 317(2), 338, 336(2) and 111 of the B.N.S. and put up for hearing.</p> <p>2. Heard Shri Devnandan Yadav learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Shri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State and perused the record including the case diary.</p> <p>3. The short case of the prosecution as per written typed complaint of the informant Harikant Kumar, S.I. is that on 20.02.2026 during course of checking he got a secret information that two boys, namely, Raja Kumar and Raushan Kumar have to come from Odhanpur towards Warisaliganj on a stolen Honda Unicorn motorcycle, where, registration number was mentioned on the back plate of motorcycle as BR27F3723 and on the front of the motorcycle there was broken plate with number mentioned as 27F-37. It is stated that during course of checking at about 12.40 HRS, with the help of police personnel they were apprehended and on inquiry,</p>

both of them disclosed their names as Raja Kumar and Raushan Kumar and Raja Kumar told that the said motorcycle is stolen one and the same is of his friend Rohit Kumar and he took said motorcycle from his friend, namely, Rohit Kumar and the said motorcycle had purchased by Rohit Kumar in the month of December from Abhay Kumar @ Bobby and Dhiraj Kumar. It is also alleged that photographs of various motorcycles with registration numbers which are BR01HB-8747, BR27J-8736, BR21V-4702, BR01FQ-9044, BR21Q-6517, BR27J-301, BR27J-3068, BR21U-5869 and transaction of Rs.20,000/- have found in galary of the seized mobiles from Raja Kumar. Accused-Raushan Kumar disclosed that accused persons, namely, Raja and Rohit are his friends and they are engaged in sale and purchase of stolen motorcycle. On query, Raja Kumar also told that he has two stolen motorcycle one is in the possession of Kundan Kumar and another is in his possession. It is further alleged that on the identification of Raja Kumar police went to the house of Raja Kumar and Kundan Kumar where no motorcycle was found there and on query family members Raja Kumar & Kundan Kumar told that said both motorcycles were parked near Koshi-Roh main road, thereafter the police went there and found that two motorcycle were parked there which registration no is 24V4 (broken condition) Chassis No.MBLBLJAR-025JGC07354 and

registration no. BR27JB068, Chassis No.MBLHA9125JH000375. Raja Kumar told that he and Kundan Kumar purchased the motorcycle No.BR27J3068 from Sachin Chaudhary bearing mobile no.9693393896 / 93451065965 and Samar Jha mobile no.7292844665. On verification of Honda Unicorn motorcycle registration no. BR27F3723, Engine No.K619E-1-0112318, Chassis No.NE4KC192CF8027794 through e-challan the registration no. and chassis number were found of two different vehicle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has got one criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 21.02.2026. It is further submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in the present case on the basis of suspicion. It is also submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and he has no concern with Raushan Kumar. Hence bail petition of the petitioner may be allowed.

On the contrary the learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

5. The petitioner-Raja Kumar is in custody since 21.02.2026. He has been apprehended by the police during course of checking, with stolen motorcycle, which he was driving along with other co-accused who happens to be CICL. This accused-petitioner was driving the said stolen

motorcycle. Further, two stolen motorcycle, one of red and black colour, Hero Glamour Motorcycle and the other was red and black Hero Passion Pro motorcycle bearing registration nos. BR27J3068 Chasis No.MBLHA9125JH000375, the investigating officer found after verifying the registration number and Chasis number of seized vehicle which belonged to different vehicle. The investigation is still going on. Further, the petitioner has stated in para 3 of the bail petition that he has no criminal antecedent, which is absolutely wrong and this has been done with a view to conceal his criminal antecedent. In para 58 of the case diary it is mentioned that he is accused in Roh P.S. Case No.347 of 2025 under Section 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 74, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S.

6. In view of the above this court does not think it fit just, proper and legal to admit the petitioner on bail, at this stage. Accordingly, the prayer for regular bail of the accused-petitioner Raja Kumar is being **rejected** hereby.
