This Bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **Dhananjay Kumar** who is in custody since 21.02.2026 in connection with **Mahila P.S Case No.- 08/2026** registered U/Ss. 69/351(2)/3(5) B.N.S. Copy of this B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Prosecution story, in short, is that informant stayed at the house of Sarju Chaudhary of Shiv Nagar, Nawada as a tenant from March 2025 to July 2025 in connection with preparation for home guard examination. During this period she came into contact with accused who allured her in the name of marriage. On 05.04.2025 at about 06:00 P.M., petitioner came at the resident of informant and stayed in night on pretext of non-availability of vehicle for his village. In the night, he forcibly made physically relation with her and again assure her for marriage. Later on she got pregnant and thereafter, petitioner shifted her to Gaya and stayed there in a rented house as husband and wife but later on he denied to marry with her.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged and he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Allegation against the petitioner is that he allegedly established physical relation with the informant on the false promise of marriage which resulted in her pregnancy and thereafter, he refused to marry with her and also extended threat.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation, the petitioner is not entitled to be enlarged on bail, as such his prayer for granting regular bail is hereby **rejected**.
