Remarks

1. This A.B.P. is filed by the accused Gunjesh Kumar who is apprehending his arrest for committing an offence U/s 303(2), 318(2), 318(4), 319(2), 336(2), 336(3), 338, 340(2), 317(2), 317(5), 111, 61(2) of the B.N.S., 2023 and 66(B), 66(C), 66(D) of I.T. Act arising out of Cyber P.S. Case No. 17/2026.

2. The brief facts of the case are that the informant, who is posted as a Inspector at the Cyber Police Station, received a complaint on the Pratibimb App on 20.02.2026 at about 11:30 a.m., and the location was traced near Village Apsad under Warisaliganj. Upon informing the higher officials, a raiding team was duly constituted. When the said team reached Village Apsad, two boys, who were engaged in certain activities on mobile phones, upon noticing the police party, attempted to flee from the spot. By use of reasonable force, one of them was apprehended by the police, while the other managed to escape. On interrogation, the apprehended accused disclosed his name as Kamlesh Kumar and further revealed the name of the absconding accused as Gunjesh Kumar. Upon search of the apprehended accused, two smartphones were recovered from his left pocket. On further examination of the said mobile devices, a QR code, certificates pertaining to fraudulent loan services in the name of Bajaj Finance Company, WhatsApp chats, and several screenshots were found and recovered. Accordingly, the accused was arrested, and the recovered articles were duly seized in accordance with law.

3. According to para 2 of the bail petition, petitioner has not filed any anticipatory bail or regular bail either before this Hon'ble Court or before the Hon'ble High Court.

4. As per para 3 of the bail petition, the petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and no case as alleged by the prosecution is made out against him. The petitioner was not involved in the alleged crime and his name was disclosed by the apprehended accused due to enmity. Further there is no chance of his absconding as he undertakes to present himself before the police and Court as and when directed to

	<p>appear. The petitioner further undertakes not to temper with the evidence or witnesses in any manner and will not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court. Hence he be enlarged on bail.</p> <p>6. Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.</p> <p>7. Heard both the sides and perused the record.</p> <p>8. On perusal of the records it appears that during police raid one person was apprehended and two mobile phones and QR code, certificates pertaining to fraudulent loan services in the name of Bajaj Finance Company, WhatsApp chats, and several screenshots were found which were used by the accused persons for using cyber related offences. The petitioner managed to escape from the scene of occurrence at the time of raid but his name has been specifically mentioned by the apprehended accused person who was found with doubtful articles and mobile phones indicating his severe engagement in the cyber related offences. The matter is still under investigation.</p> <p>9. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Gunjesh Kumar at this stage. Hence the A.B.P. is rejected in view of the aforesaid discussion.</p> <p>10.
