This Bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner 1. **Nitish Kumar** who is in custody since 17.12.2025 in connection with **Akbarpur P.S Case No. 516/2025** registered U/Ss. 317(5) B.N.S. Copy of this B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that earlier regular bail petition vide B.P. No.- 61/2026 had been filed which was rejected on 18.02.2026 by this court with observation that petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge, if so advised. He has further submitted that charge has been framed on 02.03.2026 against the petitioner. He is in custody since 17.12.2025. Hence petitioner deserves bail.

Learned P.P. has been conceded the same.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Vide order dated 18.02.2026 passed in B.P. no.- 61/2026, a liberty was given to the petitioner to renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge. From perusal of order dated 09.03.2026 of trial court it appears that charges have been framed in this case.

Considering the above observation, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly petitioner is allowed on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each. Further condition is that one bailor must be family member of the petitioner.
