This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **1. Dinesh Kumar @ Dinesh Chauhan 2. Upendra Chauhan** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with **Pakribarawan P.S Case No.-123/2026** registered U/Ss. 318(4)/319(2)/336(3)/338/340(2)/111(4)/3(5) B.N.S. and 66/66(B)/66(C)/66(D) I.T. Act. Copy of this A.B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Informant is being A.S.I. of Pakribarawan P.S. along with other police personnel were on day patrolling duty on dated 22.03.2026 and at about 13:15 he got a secret information that Sidhnath Chauhan, member of organised Cyber criminal gang was committing cyber crime along with other accused persons at the bank of pond situated near his house of village Madhrapur P.S., Pakribarawan, Dist.- Nawda. Informant along with police personnel reached near pond where some people were seen talking on mobile on the ridges of field but they all 10-11 in number started fleeing on seeing police personnel. During course of chase, police personnel reached near the house of accused Sidhnath Chauhan and seen that a person is trying himself to hide by entering a room (without any door). Other accused persons managed to escape. At about 14:05 O'clock police went to the room and saw that a person kept himself hide inside and he told his name as Sidhnath Chauhan. On search of accused one mobile of Vivo Company was found and from gallery of the seized mobile many tickets of Kerala lottery, lottery draw ticket, scanner and evidence of committing cyber fraud was recovered from the WhatsApp chat. SIM no. of the seized mobile is 8282857042. A 100 rupees note was also found from cover of this mobile. Apart from that, from the seized (I) mobile screen short relating to number of lottery tickets total in eight pages (ii) One page screen shorts relating to number of lottery tickets (iii) WhatsApp chat with mobile no.- 9593387557, one ATM card of NSDL payment bank (iv) ATM card of P.N.B. bank issued in the name of Sidhnath Chauhan (v) ATM card of S.B.I. bank issued in the name of Sidhnath Chauhan (vi) SBI ATM card in the name of Shivmanti Devi. (vii) Bank card in the name of Geeta Devi were recovered. It has been stated that the accused with mobile number, forged SIM, scanner, forged ticket of Kerala lottery, forged draw ticket number etc., all

are tickets using to commit cyber fraud was given by his co-villager Subelal Chauhan who used to take half money and rest half was given to him. Arrested accused has also stated the name of accused persons who were managed to escape are as Subalal Chauhan, Surendra Chauhan Pankaj Chauhan 4. Dinesh Chauhan 5. Upendra Chauhan 6. Raja Kumar 7. Rajneeti Chauhan 8. Birendra Chauhan and 9. Saurabh Chauhan .

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged. He has been falsely implicated in the case. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Witnesses have supported the case as per para no.- 04, 05, 06 of case diary. In para no.- 13, confessional statement of co-accused Sidhnath Chauhan is mentioned in which he has given detailed description, how he and co-accused Subelal Chauhan and other co-accused persons used to commit cyber fraud in the name of Kerala lottery ticket. He has also stated that co-accused Subelal Chauhan provide forged SIM, QR code mobile etc. But other accused persons and all accused persons used to commit cyber fraud in the leadership of Subelal Chauhan from the field of his village. He has again stated that they used to advertise forged Kerala lottery ticket on Facebook and trapped people. Thereafter, people used to contact with whatsapp chat and purchased for Kerala Lottery ticket and they charged Rs. 149 for one ticket and Rs. 298 for three tickets through QR code. Thereafter, Subelal provide them a ticket draw page which was sent to the person to purchase the ticket and accused person take Rs. 2,000/- as a registration fees through QR code. Thereafter, Subelal provide them a ticket draw page which was sent to the person to purchase the ticket and accused persons take Rs. 2,000/- as a registration fees through QR code. Thereafter, they take Rs. 5,000/- in the name of one certificate and also for GST charge. All amount were obtained from QR code.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail, as such his prayer for anticipatory bail stands **rejected**.
