06.05.2026	B.P. No.539/2026 and B.P. No.668/2026 have been filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, Md. Imran and Md. Azmat @ Md. Ajmatullah, respectively who are in custody since 08.04.2026 in connection with Roh P.S. Case No.67/2026 under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 117(2), 109(2) and 351(2) of the B.N.S. put up for hearing. Both the aforesaid bail petitions are heard together and are being disposed of by this common order. 2. Heard Shri Niranjana Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Shri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State and perused the record including the case diary. 3. The short case of the prosecution as per fardbeyan of the informant is that on 29.01.2026 at about 10:00 A.M., when he was going to Roh from his house and reached near <i>Samrain Paain</i>, all the accused persons including the petitioners stopped him and assaulted him by means of lathi, danda, iron rod, etc. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioner-Md. Imran has got one criminal antecedent i.e. Akbarpur P.S. Case No.112/2026,	

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where, petitioner-Md. Azmat @ Md. Ajmatullah has got no criminal antecedent and they are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case and have not committed any offence as alleged. It has further been submitted that there is no specific allegation against these petitioners. Hence bail petitions of the petitioners may be allowed.

On the contrary the learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners.

5. Both the B.P.No. 539/2026 and B.P. No. 668/2026 are being disposed of by this common order since both cases arise of the same Roh P.S.case no. 67/2026. The petitioner Md. Irman is in custody since 18.03.2026 and petitioner Md. Azmat @ Ajmatullah is in custody since 08.04.2026. Petitioner Md. Imran is accused in Akbarpur P.S.case no. 112/2026 whereas petitioner Md. Azmat @ Ajamtullah has no got no criminal antecedent.. There is general and omnibus allegation levelled against all the accused persons including these petitioners of assaulting the informant and injury in his finger as well as on his waist. The injury report has been brought on record which shows that NCCT of brain is normal, X-ray of right knee is normal, X-ray of chest normal and X-ray of pelvis is normal. All the injuries were found to be simple in nature caused by hard and blunt object. Further from the perusal of the case diary it is clear from para 27 of the case diary the witnesses have stated that there is land dispute between the parties for which the said altercation occurred.

6. In view of the above this court thinks it fit just,

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Contd. 06.05.2026	proper and legal to admit the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for regular bail of the accused-petitioners, namely, Md. Imran and Md. Azmat @ Md. Ajmatullah, are being allowed hereby and the they are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to the conditions that the petitioners shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which they are accused, or suspected, of the commission of which they are suspected, they will not tamper with the evidence, they shall remain present on each and every date during trial and if the they fail to appear on two consecutive dates their bail-bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
