Attendance has been filed on behalf of applicant. Heard learned counsel for the applicant as well as Ld. P.P. for State.

This Cr. Misc. case has been filed on behalf of applicant to transfer the case Muffasil P.S. Case No.-222/2024 which is pending in the Ld. court of A.C.J.M.-1st, Nawada to the Learned court of D.A.S.J.-XI, Nawada for trial and disposal. It is further submitted that applicant is accused in Session Trial bearing No.-263/2025 (arising out of Muffasil P.S. Case No.-215/2024) and Muffasil P.S. Case No.-222/2024. It has further submitted that S.Tr. Case No.-263/2025 is currently pending before the Ld. Court of D.A.S.J.-XI, Nawada and both cases arising out from same day of occurrence and related to each other, so it should be tried in one criminal court, hence, order may be passed in this regard.

The learned P.P. for state has submitted that both cases are related to each other. So, both cases should be tried in one court for just decision in view of laws laid down in judgment passed by Hon'ble Apex Court reported in AIR 2001, SC,826 and in 1990 Supp SCC145 i.e. (Nathilal Vs State of U.P.).

Perused the record alongwith case records of S.Tr. No.-263/2025 (State Vs. Rajesh Prasad) arising out from Muffasil P.S. Case No.-215/2024 and Muffasil P.S. Case NO.-222/2024 (State Vs. Rajesh Prasad), it appears that both cases arose from the same occurrence and applicant is accused in abovementioned both cases as well as both cases

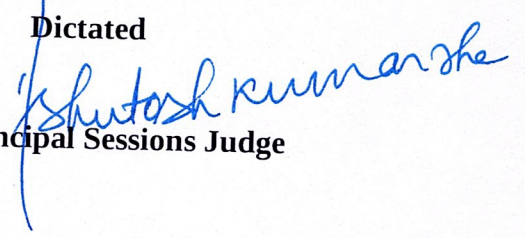
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are related to each other and it is proper that both cases should be tried by same judge.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case the present Criminal Miscellaneous is hereby **allowed** and it is ordered that case record of Muffasil P.S. case No.-222/2024 which pending in the learned court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-1st, Nawada is recalled and same is transferred to the Ld. D.A.S.J.-XI, Nawada for disposal. Send a copy of this order at once to the courts concerned for proceeding further in accordance with the law.
