The application for anticipatory bail U/s.438 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed before or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

The I.O. has submitted Compliance report stating that no such application is pending before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has raised objection to the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the FIR and other materials in the C.D.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case and bearing in mind the extent of complicity of the present accused, as transpires from the materials available in the Case Diary, more particularly, the statement of witnesses U/s.161 of Cr.P.C. and considering the medical papers including the Injury report and the stage of investigation, I do not want to stand on the way of admitting the accused petitioner with an order of pre-arrest bail. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands allowed.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioner as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, he shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each on condition that the accused petitioner will meet with the I.O. once in a week till completion of investigation, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

If released on bail, the petitioner is directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
