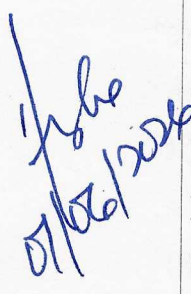

01.06.2026 	A.B.P.No. 1205/2026, A.B.P. No. 1221/2026, A.B.P. No.1226/2026 & A.B.P. No.1306/2026 have been filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, Shahzad Miyan @ Chapta, Md. Amir Ali @ Md. Amir, Subodh Mahto @ Subodh Kumar, Vikas Ray @ Vikas Raj, Subham Kumar, Sintu Kumar @ Sudhanshu Kumar, Dipu Kumar, Sujeet Kumar, Ritik Kumar, Pappu Yadav @ Parmeshwar Yadav, Sala Uddin respectively, who are apprehending their arrest in	

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connection with Roh P.S. Case No.127/2026 under Sections 115(2), 125(a), 126(2), 191(2), 193(3), 192, 196(2), 298, 299, 326(g) and 132 of the B.N.S., put up for hearing. Both the aforesaid bail petitions are being taken together and are being disposed of by this common order.

2. Heard Shri Sanjay Kumar Priyadarshi in A.B.P.No. 1205/2026, A.B.P. No. 1221/2026 & A.B.P. No.1226/2026 and Shri Nitish Kumar in A.B.P. No.1306/2026, the learned counsels for the petitioners as well as Shri Manoj Kumar Singh, the learned P.P. for the state.

3. The short case of the prosecution as per the written typed complaint of the informant Ravi Prakash, Labour Enforcement Officer, Roh is that on 28.03.2026 at about 19:45 P.M. during Ramnavami procession lots of persons belongs to Muslim community standing near Masjid and when the persons of Hindu communities crossed the southern side of Masjid Gali both of the communities started slogan against each other and due to which there were hot exchange of words taken place between the two communities. It is alleged that all the accused persons including these petitioners started pelting stones over each other and also they pelted stones

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to community. It has been further submitted that there is general and omnibus allegation as regard to participation in procession on the eve of Ramnavmi and provocative religious slogan has been levelled against these petitioners. It has also been submitted that other co-accused persons have already been enlarged on bail by this Court. Hence, the anticipatory bail petitions of the petitioners may be allowed.

On the other hand the learned P.P. opposed the anticipatory bail petitions of the petitioners.

5. A.B.P.No. 1205/2026, A.B.P. No. 1221/2026, A.B.P. No.1226/2026 & A.B.P. No.1306/2026 are being disposed of by this common order as all these petitions arise out of same police station case number bearing Roh P.S. Case No.127/2026.

It is alleged that these petitioners were found on the spot on the basis of video recording of the said incident. There is general and omnibus allegation against them involving in the said incident. Apart from that the petitioners Shahzad Miyan @ Chapta, Md. Amir Ali @ Md. Amir in A.B.P. No.1205/2026 have no criminal antecedent. In A.B.P. No.1221/2026, petitioner no.2 Vikas Ray @ Vikas Raj, petitioner no.3 Subham Kumar, petitioner no.4 Sintu Kumar @ Sudhanshu Kumar, petitioner no.5 Dipu

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Kumar, petitioner no.6 Sujeet Kumar, petitioner no.7 Ritik Kumar have no criminal antecedent, whereas, petitioner no.1, Subodh Mahto @ Subodh Kumar is accused in Roh P.S. Case No.176/2026 under Section 30(a), 41, 37 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, in which he is on bail. In A.B.P. No.1226/2026 Pappu Yadav @ Parmeshwar Yadav has no criminal antecedent. In A.B.P. No.1306/2026, petitioner-Sala Uddin has no criminal antecedent.

6. In view of the above this court thinks it fit just, proper and legal to admit the petitioners on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail petitions of the accused-petitioners, namely, Shahzad Miyan @ Chapta, Md. Amir Ali @ Md. Amir, Subodh Mahto @ Subodh Kumar, Vikas Ray @ Vikas Raj, Subham Kumar, Sintu Kumar @ Sudhanshu Kumar, Dipu Kumar, Sujeet Kumar, Ritik Kumar, Pappu Yadav @ Parmeshwar Yadav, Sala Uddin are being allowed hereby and it is ordered that in the event of surrender/arrest within four weeks from today the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/ (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S. with further conditions that the

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
