15.06.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners 1.Md. Naushad Alam and 2.Md. Raja @ Akhlakur Rehman who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Town P.S. Case No.367/2026 u/ss. 308(5), 308(3), 352, 351(2), 326(g) and 3(5) of the B.N.S Section 27 of the Arms Act and put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri Arun Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Md. Tarique, learned I/c. P.P. for the State. Perused the record including the case diary. 3. The short case of the prosecution as per written complaint of the informant Faridi Begum is that she had taken loan of Rs.1,00,000/- on interest from one Naushad Alam. It is stated that on 07.04.2026 at about 12:00 A.M. all the accused persons including these petitioners came in front of the door of the house of the informant and started hitting on the door and abusing as well as threatened to kill her and her family. It is alleged that accused-Naushad Alam had fired shot on the wall of the house of the informant, when, they were hiding on the roof of the house. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the Petitioner no.2 has no

criminal antecedent, whereas, petitioner no.1 is accused in Town P.S. Case No.288/2019 under Section 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 354B and 379 of the IPC in which he is on bail. It has been submitted that petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in the present case. It has further been submitted that the allegation has been levelled against these petitioners is general and omnibus in nature. Hence, anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners may be allowed.

On the contrary learned P.P. opposed the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners.

5. Allegation against petitioner no.1 is that he has fired from an illegal firearms and against there is general and omnibus levelled against petitioner no.2. Petitioner no.2 has no criminal antecedent, whereas, petitioner no.1 is accused in Town P.S. Case No.288/2019 under Section 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 354B and 379 of the IPC in which he is on bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner is submitted that the matter is actually about the giving house of the informant in mortgage to the accused side and money was taken on loan. Later on, they agreed to sale their house, which was mortgaged, but when legal notice has been sent by the accused-persons they tried to implicate in the present case. Copy of the said agreement has been brought on record.

6. In view of the above, this court thinks it fit just, proper and legal to admit the petitioners on

anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused-petitioners 1.Md. Naushad Alam and 2.Md. Raja @ Akhlakur Rehman are being **allowed** hereby and it is ordered that in the event of surrender/arrest within four weeks from today the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the B.N.S.S. with further conditions that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required and the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer, the petitioners shall remain present on each and every date during the trial and if the petitioners fail to appear on two consecutive dates their bail-bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
