This Bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **Manoj Manjhi** who is in custody since 03.04.2026 in connection with **Warisaliganj P.S Case No.- 224/2026** registered U/Ss. 305(e)/317(2)/111/3(5) B.N.S. Copy of this B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that on 02.04.2026, the informant received secret information that illegal sand was being transported. Acting upon the said information, he along with other police personnel proceeded to the northern side of village Makanpur, where illegal sand was allegedly being loaded. On seeing the police team, the drivers of the vehicles attempted to flee from the spot; however, after a chase, two persons were apprehended. Upon interrogation, they disclosed their names as Sagan Kumar and Manoj Manjhi. Thereafter, the tractor bearing reg. no. BR46G8154 and reg. no.- not available, Eng. no. RHD4YBA1528 was seized.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged and he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has no any criminal antecedent.

Learned PP opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Letter no.- 1640/kh dated 19.06.2026 address to Sri Santosh Kumar relating to depositing of fine amount of Rs. 1,01,614/- by seized tractor Eng. no.- RHD4YBA1528 in case no.- 224/2026 has been filed. From perusal of letter it appear that fine amount has been deposited. It has been submitted by the owner of this

tractor that the accused petitioner was driving the said tractor at the time of alleged of occurrence and in support an affidavit has also been filed by him. Fine amount was deposited this Court.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly petitioner is allowed on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each. Further condition is that one bailor must be family member of the petitioner.
