This Bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **1. Billu Chaudhary @ Ashok Kumar** who is in custody since 27.05.2026 in connection with **Nawada P.S Case No.- 1270/2025** registered U/Ss. 190/191(2)/115(2)/126(2)/103(1)/61(2) B.N.S. Copy of this B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

The prosecution story in short is that on dated 06.12.2025 at about 07:00 PM, informant's son Prashant Raj went outside and after 10 minutes Bablu Singh came and told her that accused persons were assaulting her son with lathi, danda and knives. She further alleged that after that she ran to the place of occurrence and then she came to know that Prashant's friends had taken him to the hospital for treatment and when she arrived at the hospital, she saw that her son (deceased Prashant Raj) was lying dead and his friends were standing beside him. She further alleged that due to previous dispute with accused-petitioner Billu Chaudhary, her son was murdered by the accused persons.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged and he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner is one criminal antecedent.

Learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. Accused-petitioner is named in the FIR. Confessional statement of co-accused Rahul Kumar @ Ranvir @ Butta is available on record and in his confessional statement he confessed that he along with other accused persons killed the deceased Prashant Raj. Witnesses in para 7 & 8 of the case diary support the story of

prosecution. In para 18 of Case diary, witness Raushan Kumar stated that due to previous dispute accused persons killed informant's son and he has also stated that all the accused persons are gang member of accused-petitioner Billu Chaudhary Who is in jail, and he had planned this incident from jail. On perusal of confessional statement of accused-petitioner Billu Chaudhary mentioned in para 73 of case diary. It becomes clear that he has confessed that when he appeared for his BA examination from jail, he met other co-accused Vikash Kumar @ Tiger and Ranveer @ Butta and at that time they hatched the plan of killing the deceased. Para 168 shows that petitioner has criminal antecedents of 20 cases. Cognizance has been taken against co-accused u/s 191(2), 190, 191(3), 126(2), 115(2), 103(1), 61(2) of BNS. Matter is serious in nature and investigation is still going on against this petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation, the petitioner is not entitled to be enlarged on bail, as such his prayer for granting regular bail is hereby **rejected**.
