18.06.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Birendra Pal, who is in custody since 18.05.2026 in connection with Roh P.S. Case No. 08/2026 u/s 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2) and 352 of the B.N.S. put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri Sanjay Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Shri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State and perused the record including the case diary. 3. Short case of the prosecution as per written complaint of the informant Shiv Shankar Pal is that on 06.01.2026, when he returned to his house after grazing wolf, all the the accused persons including this petitioner entered into his house and assaulted him by means of <i>lathi-danda</i>, rod, etc. It is alleged that they have taken away cash of Rs.5,000/- and gold chain, too. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 18.05.2026. It has been further submitted that the petitioner is innocent rather he has falsely been implicated in the present case due to enmity. It has also been submitted that no specific allegation as regard to assault has been levelled against this petitioner, hence, the bail	

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petition of the petitioner may be allowed.

On the contrary learned P.P. opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

5. The petitioner is in custody since 18.05.2026. The allegation against this petitioner is general and omnibus in nature that along with other co-accused persons they have assaulted on the person of the informant. The injury report has been brought on record, which shows that lacerated wound size 1/4"X1/4"X muscle deep on the right side of forehead and abrasion on forehead, abrasion on right ear pinna and swelling on left side of head. The supplementary injury report has been brought on record and the x-ray of forearm shows no bony injury seen. CT-scan of brain, no significant abnormality. The said injury was found to be simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. As per body of the FIR the specific allegation is upon Ishwar Pal, who is not the petitioner over here of assaulting over head of the informant by iron rod. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

6. In view of the above this court thinks it fit just, proper and legal to admit the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for regular bail of the accused-petitioner Birendra Pal is being **allowed** hereby and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to the conditions that

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the petitioner shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected, the petitioner will not tamper with the evidence and he shall remain present on each and every date during the trial and if he fails to appear on two consecutive dates his bail-bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
