05.06.2026	This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely, Chhotelal Ram, who is in custody since 09.05.2026 in connection with Roh P.S. Case No.76/2026 u/s 191(2), 190, 126(2), 117(2), 109(1), 61(2) and 352 of the B.N.S. put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri Ramchandra Rajbanshi, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Shri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State and perused the record including the case diary. 3. Short case of the prosecution as per written complaint of the informant Rita Devi is that his son and daughter of Mana Ram, namely, Nibha Kumari has solemnized their marriage. It is alleged that on 01.03.2026 at about 07:00, a Panchayati was convened to pacify the dispute between both the parties. It is alleged that during that course all the accused persons including this petitioner started abusing her and also assaulted her and her husband. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 09.05.2026 . It has been further submitted that the petitioner is innocent rather he has falsely been implicated in the present and he has not committed any offence. It has also been	

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submitted that no specific allegation has been levelled against this petitioner, hence, the bail petition of the petitioner may be allowed.

On the contrary learned P.P. opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

5. The petitioner-Chhotelal Ram is in custody since 09.05.2026. The said issue is alleged to be occurred between the parties over enticing away the daughter of one of the co-accused, namely, Mana Ram by the son of the informant. A panchayati was conducted in which an altercation took place between the parties. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The injury report has been brought on record, which shows only one injury on the person of informant, Rita Devi which is lacerated wound of size 2 ½ X ½" X muscle on forehead. X-ray report has not been brought on record. The nature of injury mentioned as simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance, as per supplementary injury report. There is no repetition of blow.

6. In view of the above this court thinks it fit just, proper and legal to admit the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for regular bail of the accused-petitioner, namely, Chhotelal Ram is being **allowed** hereby and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to the conditions that the petitioner shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of

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
