This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioners 1.Babu Lall Singh @ Lall Babu @ Bittu, 2.Dilip Singh, 3.Vijay Singh, 4.Abhay Kumar @ Funtun, 5.Sadan Singh and 6.Pankaj Singh, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Roh P.S. Case No.181/2026 u/ss. 115(2), 126(2), 109(1), 118(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of the B.N.S and put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri Upendra Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Shri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State. Perused the record including the case diary. 3. The short case of the prosecution as per the written statement of the informant Sudhir Singh is that on 26.05.2026 at about 07:00 P.M., while he was crossing the street between the houses of Lal Babu @ Bittu Singh, Sadan Singh and Dilip Singh, the accused-Lal Babu @ Bittu Singh casted remark and objected to use the street. It is alleged that on protest, the accused persons including these petitioners started assaulting him. It is further alleged that when the persons of informant's side came to save him, they also assaulted them by

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioner no.1.Babu Lall Singh @ Lall Babu @ Bittu and petitioner no.2, Dilip Singh, are accused in Roh P.S. Case No.107/2017 u/s 341, 323, 307, 504/34 of the IPC and 3(1)(x) of the SC/ST Act and Roh P.S. Case No.59/2022 u/s 341, 323, 379, 504, 506/34 of the IPC and petitioner no.3.Vijay Singh, and petitioner no.4, Abhay Kumar @ Funtun are accused in only Roh P.S. Case No.59/2022 u/s 341, 323, 379, 504, 506/34 of the IPC, whereas, petitioner no.5, Sadan Singh and 6.Pankaj Singh have no criminal antecedent.. It has been submitted that petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in the present case due to land dispute. It has further been submitted that there is case and counter case in between the parties. Hence, anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners may be allowed. On the contrary learned I/c. P.P. opposed the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners. 5. From perusal of para 35 of the case diary, petitioner no.1.Babu Lall Singh @ Lall Babu @ Bittu and petitioner no.2, Dilip Singh, are accused in Roh P.S. Case No.107/2017 u/s 341, 323, 307, 504/34 of the IPC and 3(1)(x) of the SC/ST Act and Roh P.S. Case No.59/2022 u/s 341, 323, 379, 504, 506/34 of the IPC, and

petitioner no.3.Vijay Singh, and petitioner no.4, Abhay Kumar @ Funtun are accused in Roh P.S. Case No.59/2022 u/s 341, 323, 379, 504, 506/34 of the IPC, whereas, petitioner no.5, Sadan Singh and 6.Pankaj Singh have no criminal antecedent. There is general and omnibus allegation levelled against the petitioners. The injury reports have been brought on record, which show the injury suffered by Sudhir Singh is abrasion on the nose, left cheek, head, right hand and right knee, swelling on the neck. The supplementary report shows X-ray radiography of forearm shows no any fracture/dislocation and soft tissue appears normal. The injury found on the person of Ashutosh Kumar is swelling 4"X3" on the left forearm and abrasion 1/4"X1/4", lacerated wound 1/2"X1/4"X skin deep over head and swelling 1/4"X1/4" on right leg toe and lacerated wound 1/4"X1/4"X skin deep. The supplementary report shows fracture noted at ulna left with associated soft tissue swelling on left forearm and X-ray report shows normal. The injury report of Shubham Kumar shows lacerated wound of size 1"X1/4"Xmuscle deep on left eyebrow and pain in neck. The x-ray report shows normal and no significant abnormality.

6. In view of the above, this court thinks it fit just, proper and legal to admit the petitioners

on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused-petitioners 1.Babu Lall Singh @ Lall Babu @ Bittu, 2.Dilip Singh, 3.Vijay Singh, 4.Abhay Kumar @ Funtun, 5.Sadan Singh and 6.Pankaj Singh, are being **allowed** hereby and it is ordered that in the event of surrender/arrest within four weeks from today the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the B.N.S.S. with further conditions that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required and the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer, the petitioners shall remain present on each and every date during the trial and if the petitioners fail to appear on two consecutive dates their bail-bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
