This Bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **Raju Yadav** who is in custody since 04.04.2026 in connection with **Nardiganj P.S Case No.- 125/2026** registered U/Ss. 305 B.N.S. Copy of this B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that earlier petitioner has filed a bail petition before this court vide B.P. no.- 752/2026 which was rejected on dated 11.05.2026 with observation that petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after submission of charge sheet, if so advised. Further he has submitted that Charge sheet has now available on record. Thus, petitioner deserves bail.

Learned P.P. has been conceded the same.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. On perusal of record it appears that charge-sheet vide C.S. no.- 192/2026 dated 27.05.2026 has been submitted against the petitioner which is available on record.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly petitioner is allowed on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each. **Further condition is that one bailor must be family member of the petitioner and he will also file undertaking that he will not involved in such offence in future.**
