This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner 1. **Rajesh Kumar** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Complaint Case No. 1095/2021** registered U/Ss 498(A) and 323 of I.P.C. Copy of this A.B.P. has already been served to the Ld. P.P.

Prosecution story in short is that marriage of complainant was solemnized with accused-petitioner in the year 2017. Later on, her husband-petitioner used to beat her and she fell ill. Thereafter, petitioner and his family member started demanding fifty thousand for her treatment. Lastly, on 15.08.2021 accused persons ousted her from house after taking her ornaments etc.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged. He has been falsely implicated in the case. Petitioner is husband of complainant.

Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer of the petitioner for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. It is pertinent to mention here that complainant present in person in the court on dated 09.02.2026 and expressed her readiness to go to sasural and matter was referred to the Mediation Center, D.L.S.A., Nawada. Report of mediator received on 02.02.2026 in which it has been mentioned that complainant was present but petitioner accused never appeared there. Calls were also made on the mobile number of petitioner but he did not respond and mediation accordingly remained unsuccessful. Petitioner is husband of complainant.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and report of mediation center, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail, as such his prayer for anticipatory bail stands **rejected**.
